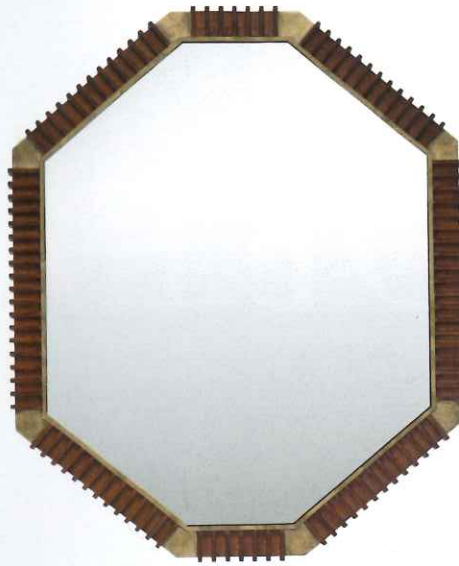

In his new line for Hickory Chair, David Phoenix zeroes in on all the gorgeous details.
